#### **PASTOR'S DESK**

There is a practice for many Christians during Epiphany, the celebration of the Wise Men following the star to find Jesus, that a "star word" is chosen as a guidance for the year. My word for 2024 has been "Abundance." I wrote it in Sharpie on a yellow paper star and tucked it beside my car's speedometer, so every time I drive, I am reminded of it. Some days, when my energy feels low or I'm questioning whether I have the gifts, talent, or hope needed to meet the road ahead, this little star catches my eye and reminds me: there is abundance, and it's not all up to me.

Throughout this year, I've come to understand that living from a place of abundance doesn't mean ignoring challenges or pretending there aren't real needs in our lives or community. Still, the call of scarcity is great. We live in a world with so many finite resources: money, time, energy. We can even live as if other resources are finite as well, such as creativity and hope. In moments when I've felt stretched thin, this focus on abundance has nudged me to lean on the strengths, talents, and generosity of those around me, finding that God's provision often comes through our connections and community.

One of Jesus' teachings that has come to mind often this year is the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30). In it, we see the difference between protecting what we have out of fear and investing in ways that can multiply our gifts and resources. Scarcity might lead us to bury what little we think we have, but abundance invites us to step out in trust, believing that as we offer what we can, God will bless and increase it.

This season, I invite you to consider how we, too, can live from abundance, especially as we prepare for our upcoming year of ministry. When we give to the church, whether through time, resources, or prayer, we participate in this beautiful cycle of God's abundant grace. As you prayerfully consider your pledge this year, may it be more than just a financial commitment—it is an invitation to trust that as we all

bring our gifts together, God will provide more than enough for the work ahead.

Participating in trunk or treating with Kirkwood Church, I saw this abundance in action. Handing out handfuls of candy—snickers, milky ways, twix bars—to kids in our community, I was reminded of how our church pours out love and joy into our neighborhood. In those simple, small moments, we have the chance to reflect God's boundless love.

As we continue on this journey together, may we all be reminded that God's economy is rich with possibility. Abundance is not something we have to wait for; it's something we're invited to live into now. Thank you for being part of this abundant community.
