Happy New Year!

Does that feel a bit early or odd to hear? Did you know that our Christian Calendar actually starts with Advent? You may be waiting until 2025 to tackle some new goals, but I personally love that amidst this season – a season filled with joy, a season filled with traditions, a season that can feel really fast, but also offers these times that we might move slow as we settle in with family and friends to celebrate – amidst this season we are also starting fresh.

Our year starts in the beginning. And we consider the world that God created and the waiting we experience as we wait for its re-creation. 

Since our beginning in 1908 as the Florida Methodist Orphanage, we have expanded over the years into a diverse organization serving abused, abandoned, and neglected children. That expansion has brought the realization that we have outgrown the Children's Home name and needed something that better represented the purpose we serve and the care we provide.
