Of course as we come closer to the date of my departure, there is sadness for I will miss you all terribly. Your lives became part of my and my husband's lives. Please know, I will not forget. You know I'm not perfect at names, though, so forgive me if I might forget a name or two. Still, I will look back on my time serving as your pastor as holy and precious. Thank you for being the gracious and loving people you are.



The Church We Love



It was 44 years ago on June 15, 1980 that ground was broken for this building. A special service was held and the sermon was brought by The Rev. Odell Miley, the District Superintendent. The pastor at that time was T. Gerald Williams. I have an original bulletin from that day and it is a wonderful keepsake for the church.

At that time services were held in what is now McCay Hall. The Building Committee was headed by Bernard Overmier, with members Lois Ault, Lynne Smith, P. Robert Leonard and Karl Mick. Some of these names may be familiar to you and they are to me.

This prayer was offered at the ground breaking service and I think it is powerful indeed as today we remember those first days, the great cloud of witnesses who have come before us and how much this church really means to us all.
