Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

We continue to raise funds for the 51 students we will be supporting in Day 4 Hope, where we provide food, toiletries, backpacks with school supplies and gift cards for school clothes/shoes to families experiencing homelessness. We still need to raise \$1,100 more to meet our \$5,000 goal. We met our goal last year and served the needs of 52 children and their families from Prine Elementary where several of our members also tutor children. Please pray about your giving to and participation in this needed ministry.

For those who don't know already, on April 14th I announced that effective July 1, 2024, I will begin a new appointment at Limona Village Chapel in Brandon, Florida. Here are some excerpts from that announcement for those who had not previously heard it.

I love you all and it has been a privilege to serve as your pastor these past five years. It became clear in the fall, though, that living in one city and working in another city 42 miles away was taking its toll. I was not fully present in either location.

After a long period of discernment with God, my family and my spiritual director, I asked for a new appointment in the area where I live.

My last Sunday with you will be June 16^{th.} Please remember that former pastors can only return to a prior church by invitation from the current pastor. Let me suggest that you let your new pastor be your pastor. If there is anything positive you have experienced from Emmanuel, it was not from me but from God at work in your life. Finally, our great staff will continue to be here at Emmanuel. Look to the future with joy that God has provided yet another pastor in a long line of pastors who have led Emmanuel since 1953. Your new pastor will lead you on the next part of your journey in faith.
